

# Scholarship Application



**\$2,500 Scholarship** to be applied toward tuition and books on a verified re-imbusement basis.

- ▣ \$1000 tuition/\$250 toward books for fall semester
- ▣ \$1000 tuition/\$250 toward books for spring semester, upon the scholarship chairperson receiving verification of the student being in good standing

## Requirements

This scholarship will be awarded to a high school senior or college student. Special considerations may be given to the following fields of study: political science, history, and education. Applicants may reapply each year. An interview of the finalists may be requested. Upon being named the recipient, the individual will be the expected guest at Dan Quayle Center functions and may be asked to work in a volunteer capacity when appropriate.

- ▣ A completed application form
- ▣ A high school and college transcript for college or grad school completed to date
- ▣ A hand-written autobiography—limited to one page

- ▣ Two letters of reference (non-family)
